Who We Are...

The C.W. Williams Community Health Center, Inc. (CWWCHC) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, Federally Qualified Health Center, designated Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH), and healthcare safety net founded in 1980 to provide comprehensive, affordable care to low-income populations in the Greater Charlotte area and to reduce patient loads on hospital emergency departments. Our mission is to improve spiritual, physical and psychosocial health by providing access to the highest quality comprehensive healthcare and ancillary services regardless of an individual's ability to pay. CWWCHC serves between 12,000 and 15,000 patients annually, representing over 30,000 patient encounters. Our patient- and family-centered service model helps to reduce barriers to care for at-risk groups, such as uninsured, low-income, unhoused, veteran, and immigrant populations.

CWWCHC addresses not only physical and behavioral health needs, but also the root causes of many health issues (called social determinants of health), including access to food, affordable housing, transportation, and other factors that affect health and wellness and help those at risk reach their functional capacity as successful, independent citizens. Center services include culturally and linguistically appropriate primary/preventive Medical and Dental care, Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder treatment and counseling, discount 340B Pharmacy, Women's Health, Maternal and Child Health, Pediatric Care, HIV/STI testing and treatment, Pre- and Post-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP/PEP), Medical Case Management, Case Management to address social determinants of health, Traditional Chinese Medicine (acupuncture, acupressure, herbal therapies), Remote Patient Monitoring (RPM) for chronic disease management, Ultrasound, Laboratory services, Community Health Worker services, Health Insurance Enrollment Assistance, Mobile Medical and Dental services, Community Outreach, Food Pantry, and free non-emergency Patient Transportation. For uninsured patients, CWWCHC offers a Sliding Fee Discount Program. To accommodate working families, we offer evening and weekend appointments and accept walk-ins. By offering convenient, one-stop access to comprehensive care and support services, CWWCHC helps to ensure that our most vulnerable populations do not delay seeking care and face more serious, sometimes life-threatening, health consequences. For thousands of underserved patients who have not been well integrated into healthcare systems due to cultural, economic, and/or geographic challenges, CWWCHC provides a medical and dental home and serves to minimize unnecessary emergency department visits, while lowering incidences of chronic diseases.

CWWCHC is part of a nationwide network of locally-run health centers that serve more than 28 million people nationwide and 550,000 people in North Carolina, many of whom live in remote and rural communities. Community Health Centers are on the front lines of national public health challenges- whether caring for veterans and medically underserved populations, providing opioid treatment, or responding to natural disasters and health crises. CWWCHC and many other North Carolina Community Health Centers address not just physical and behavioral health needs, but the roots of many health issues, such as access to food, housing, transportation and other factors that affect health and wellness and present barriers to accessing quality care.
